



# Evaluations of the Quran in right-wing populist media. Metapragmatic sequence analyses with topic modeling

## Introduction and Research Focus

*Es sind eben nur Moslems, die ihre "Heilige Schrift" als Lizenz zum Töten ansehen. Oder zum Frauenschlagen, wie es der Prügelvers 4:34 klar vorgibt.*

*It is only Muslims who regard their "Holy Scripture" as a license to kill. Or to beat women, as the beating verse 4:34 clearly dictates. [Translation]*

Research questions:

- How does an evaluative practice that refers to and interprets the Quran works in order to articulate the reasons for the fundamental otherness of Muslims?
  
- How can a data-driven approach such as Topic Modeling help us to identify textual patterns of Islamophobic evaluative practices concerning the Quran?

# Data

## Data

- Right-wing populist online media: *Politically Incorrect News* and *Compact Online* (PINES-Corpus)
- 24k texts / 14 mio. token / 2008–2018

## Characteristics

- "group-focused enemy" (Heitmeyer, Freiheit, and Sitzer 2020)
- small range of topics (Bubenhofer, Calleri, and Dreesen 2018)

# Methodological Approach: Grounded Theory

## Practices: REFERING | CITING | INTERPRETING | GENERALIZING

- 1) Just a small selection of hundreds of *timelessly valid Quran Commands* that Islamic "holy"-warriors have invoked for 1400 years, killing 270 million people: "*And kill them wherever you come across them, and drive them out from where they have driven you out; for the temptation to disbelief is worse than killing.*" (Sura 2, Verse 191)
- 2) *The fact that not every Muslim carries it out 100% in the sense of the Prophet and the Quran like the orthodox believers of the Islamic state does not mean that Islamic ideology can be subdivided. It is simply fascist and all-encompassing.*

## Methodological Approach: Grounded Theory

These evaluative practices lead to a differentiation between 'enlightened European reading and evaluation' and 'violent Islamic reading and evaluation' [othering]:

**Impossibility of discussing with Muslims:** *One would not understand it if one did not know Arabic. Typical Muslim-Taqiyya, if the followers of the killer-cult do not want to admit the cruelty of the Quran.*

**Impossibility of interpreting:** *that the Quran in connection with the Sunnah and the biography of Mohammed does not allow other interpretations; there is only THE ISLAM, clearly defined by the Quran*

**Muslims as receiver of commands:** *The sleepers were also normal people, quite nice, and one day they got the order: Now we blow up the towers in America. If a Muslim converts to what is in the Quran - and this cannot be denied, it is all in there - then he is dangerous.*

In conclusion those evaluative practices are based on and create language-ideological standpoints:  
**Reading is evidence (for 'the West')**/**Reading is dangerous (for Muslims)**; texts are not ambiguous;  
interpretations are poor excuses, etc.

## Methodological Approach: Topic Modeling

- topic modeling approach: suite of algorithms to determine thematic structures in a large collection of texts (e.g., Blei 2012)
- **topic**: distribution over the vocabulary in the corpus = words in a topic are ordered according to their joint co-occurrence in texts and thus show semantic coherence

Latent Dirichlet Allocation (LDA):

- documents exhibit more than one topic (Blei 2012, 78)
- *hyperparameter optimization*: topics have a different overall probability to occur in a text (Wallach et al., 2009)
- crucial output:
  - Topics
  - Distribution of topics over documents
  - Distribution of topics over words

## Methodological Approach: Topic Modeling

- How can we utilize Topic Modeling in order to identify evaluative practices in texts?
- Operationalization:
  1. topic variability in texts containing word forms with “quran”
  2. combination of topics within these texts
  3. development of topics within texts (“pathways”)
- LDA topic model
  - 20 topics in 2k documents / approx. 1 mio. token
  - stopwords: words occurring in more than 80% of the documents
  - Numbers were masked with “CARD”

## 1) Topic Variability & references on the Quran

### Topic 3: Police operations against Islamic violence

card, polizei, berichten, wegen, mann, täter, moslem, uhr, koran, opfer, tat, polizist, schwer, beid, mehrer, verletzen, person, monat, handeln, schlagen, spät, staatsanwaltschaft, berlin, foto, zunächst

e.g., “there were reports about a quran lying on the back seats of the car” (PINES\_10360)

### Topic 4: Islamist attacks abroad

card, islamisch, syrien, staat, terror, anschlag, i, moschee, terrorist, irak, krieg, töten, berichten, dschihad, paris, dschihadisten, isis, ägypten, regierung, westlich, usa, soldat, ziel, weste|westen, kampf,

e.g.: “The Allah-warriors of Boko Haram have attacked the city of Baga in the northeast of Nigeria and massacred all “unbelievers” there in conformity with the Quran.“ (PINES\_12363)

### Topic 7: Violent crimes against women, children, families

frau, kind, mann, mädchen, familie, kopftuch, mutter, tochter, vater, moslemisch, opfer, religiös, vergewaltigung, eltern, ehe, sexuell, ehefrau, vergewaltigen, heiraten, c., gericht, ehemann, richter, schwester, weiblich, angeklagte, männlich, töten, haus, urteil

e.g., “the guest of Frau Merkel ‘embellished’ the apartment with sayings from the Quran and praises to Allah and his prophet, which he wrote on furniture and walls” (PINES\_8414)

# 1) Topic Variability & references on the Quran

## Topic 14: Citation of suras from the Quran

card, allah, koran, mohammed, vers, töten, gott, sure, ungläubige, allahs, prophet, ;, christ, !, glauben, religion, daß, jude, krieg, euer, ungläubig, kämpfen, heilig, gläubige, diejenigen, gesandten, strafe, schlagen, muslim, verbieten

[...] These Muslims in the Islamic state repeat exactly the cruel deeds of their "prophet" Mohammed. It will never stop with the mass murders that have been going on for 1400 years, as long as Mohammed is considered the perfect role model and these timelessly valid orders are written in the Quran:

2:191 And slay them wherever ye come upon them and drive them out from where they have driven you out: for the temptation to disbelief is worse than killing.


2:193 And fight against them until there be no more persecution, and the religion is only Allah's.

3:151 We will cast terror into the hearts of the Unbelievers, because they have set up gods with Allah, for which He hath not sent down any authority: and their abode shall be the Fire, and evil is the abode of the unjust. [...]"

## 3) Development of topics in texts

### Sequential Analysis of topics

- How does a topic develop within a text?  
“[D]iscourses and their topics do not come out of the blue.” (Kintsch & Van Dijk 1983)
- Method:
  - texts were separated in 10 equally sized bins (according to the overall number of tokens per text)
  - mean proportion of a topic per bin
  - proportion = number of words in a bin that belong to a specific topic / number of words in bin)
- Results will be shown for topic 14 and topic 4




Development of topics in texts

texts containing topic 14







In den **Gebieten** , die die islamische Terror-Armee **ISIS** im **Irak** erobert hat , wird nun die Scharia 1:1 umgesetzt .

**Christen** , die noch nicht wie der bedauernswerte Mann auf dem **Titelbild abgeschlachtet** wurden , müssen dort ab sofort 250 **Dollar „Ungläubigen“-Steuer zahlen** .

Im **islamischen** Rechtssystem wird dies als „ Dschizya “ bezeichnet und betrifft **Christen** sowie **Juden** .

Wer diese für **irakische** Verhältnisse enorm hohe **Summe** nicht **zahlen** kann oder will , hat **drei Alternativen** :

**Auswandern** , Abkehr vom Christentum oder **Tod** .

So will die **ISIS** den **Irak christenfrei** machen , genauso wie es ihr „ perfektes **Vorbild** “ **Mohammed** im **Mutterland des Islams** , dem heutigen **Saudi-Arabien** , vollzogen hat .

Welche Idioten wünschen den Moslems hierzulande eigentlich gerade alles Gute zum Ramadan ?

Sind das Volltrottel , **suizidär** Veranlagte oder völlig Ahnungslose ?

Die **Islamisten führen** Schariagerichte ein , **verüben Massaker** an **Zivilisten** und **richten gefangengenommene Armeeangehörige** öffentlich hin .

Tausende Menschen müssen flüchten , um sich zu **retten** .

Die **Extremisten bereiten** derzeit eine **Offensive** auf die **Hauptstadt Bagdad** vor , wo das Personal **internationaler Organisationen** und **ausländischer Botschaften** in aller **Eile** aus dem Land **geflogen** wird .

Die **Allah-Krieger** der **ISIS** sind **gläubige** Moslems , genau wie die von **Al-Qaida** , **Boko Haram** , **Taliban** , **Hamas** , **Hizbollah** , **Muslimbrüder** , **Al-Shabaab** und wie sie sonst noch alle heißen .

Ihr „ **Prophet** “ und **kriegerisches Vorbild** **Mohammed** hat ihnen auf seinem **Sterbebett** im **März** 632 auf den Weg gegeben :

„ **Mir wurde aufgetragen** , alle Männer so lange zu **bekämpfen** , bis sie **sagen** , es gibt keine **Gottheit außer Allah** .

„ Der moslemische Kriegsfürst Saladin , der u. a. Jerusalem eroberte , führte diesen Auftrag **pflchtbewusst** fort und sagte im **Januar** 1189 :

„ **Ich will mich** dann auf dieses **Meer** begeben und sie bis auf ihre fernen **Inseln** verfolgen , bis keiner auf der **Erdoberfläche** übrig ist , der **Allah** nicht **anerkennt** .

„ Auch Ayatollah **Khomeini** , der das moderne **Persien** in einen **barbarischen islamischen Gottesstaat** verwandelte , äußerte sich 1979 in diesem Sinne :

„ **Wir werden unsere Revolution** in die gesamte Welt exportieren , bis der **Ruf** , Es gibt keine **Gottheit außer Gott** und **Muhammad** ist der **Gesandte Allahs** ‘ überall auf der Welt **ertönt** .

## Conclusion & Outlook

### Conclusion on evaluative practices in Islamophobic media

- Quran references and citing as evidences for the Islamic violence
- Evaluative practices in a metalingual (e.g., *beating verse*) and in a metapragmatic (e.g., *interpretation*) sense

### ...on a methodological level

- topic modeling as a method of distant reading
- interpretation of topics on a functional level leads to the identification of practices (e.g., citing and referring)
- combination of topics and their pathway within texts points towards argumentative structures (“course of a discourse”)

### ...outlook

- Larger test set needed to validate the results further
- comparison with results for other corpora
